

August 15, 1918.

Huntington Lake to Meadow above Mono Crossing. Fresno Co.

Left Lake at 10:15 and had luncheon with Miss Dan across the Lake. Reached meadow above Mono Crossing about 8 P. M. so camped there. This meadow had been a lake and the water was still a few inches deep almost all over meadow. Fringed with lodgepole pine.

Elephant's heads. In meadow.

August 16, 1918.

Meadow to Boggy Meadow.

Had a hard time finding the trail. The new trail to the bridge was not on the map. As it follows the River down for a ways, we thought we were off the trail and we went back. On the way again, we found a trail which led us to Mono Crossing. The River was too deep for us, and as the current was strong we thought it best to unpack Calamity and take her things over on Mike. I made 7 trips, taking Lula over last. Made Boggy Meadow or rather a meadow near there late that night.
